Paul Craddock: The amazing Earth energies at Knowlton

Paul will talk about his research into the Earth Energies present at the Knowlton Church Henge and circle complex. A whole range of different Earth Energy features have been dowsed at Knowlton some so strong that the majority of dowsers and even non dowsers would expect to get a physical sensation. Features include Michael and Mary type currents as documented by Hamish Miller, Energy Ley Lines, spirals, risers/droppers and much more.

Paul will bring along photographs of some of the earth energies which have appeared on many photographs. These include a photograph of an Energy Ley Line which assisted dowsers with the discovery of a fallen buried standing stone. This discovery was reported in the front page of the BSD Journal, British Archaeology magazine, local press and even Southern TV! Paul will give a guided dowsing tour of the site on Sunday morning.

Writers who have referred to Knowlton in their books include Tom Graves in his book Needles of Stone and Peter Knight in his book Ancients Stones of Dorset.

Hugo Jenks: Stonehenge, a new theory and computerised dowsing

Stonehenge has been a source of fascination and speculation for many centuries. Hugo will present the evidence behind his remarkable new theory of Stonehenge as an Astronomical Observatory. Hugo's book 'Stonehenge Astronomical Observatory' will be on sale.

Hugo will also introduce a new method he has developed to capture the Dowsing response and record it on a lap-top computer, together with GPS position. This is a significant new approach, as the results can then be correlated directly with geophysical methods such as magnetometry.

Nigel Twinn: Hamish Miller, A Life Divined

The late Hamish Miller could be described as a polymath - as well as a being a consummate dowser, he was also an accomplished author, blacksmith, philosopher and social activist. Prior to a Near Death Experienced in 1982, he was also a very successful designer, engineer and businessman. For the insights he achieved through dowsing, he was accorded near legendary status during his own lifetime, yet as a man, he was quietly-spoken, humble and self deprecating. He laughed heartily at his own failures and he described himself as 'just an ordinary bloke'. This is a journey through a life well-lived: a life full of twists and turns; a life lived to the full.

Angela Latham and Steve Douglas: The Mystery of Orbs

Most dowsers by now will have heard of Orbs - those mysterious patterned and multi-coloured spheres of light which have been appearing on photographs since the advent of digital technology. Some may dismiss the mystery and explain them away as reflections of dust or moisture particles. If only it were that simple... Angela Latham and Steve Douglas have been investigating with an open mind and have gained great critical experience alongside their thousands of photographs. Angela will talk about interactions with Orbs which indicate conscious intelligence, some of which respond to her requests. She will also share images of light forms which are thought-projections. Others may be individual souls. Earth energy or 'chi' can also be collected, thrown and photographed.
