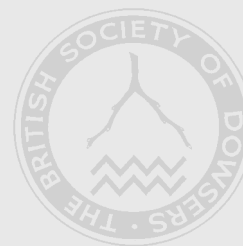

For members who have completed a BSD Foundation Course or equivalent, and who are competent with rod and pendulum, why not develop your skills by attending our two dowsing for health courses?

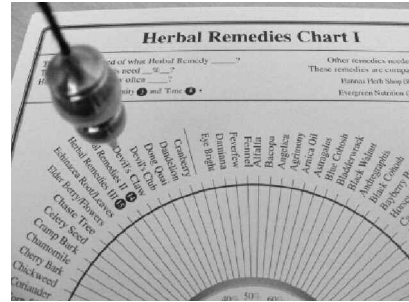
Our tutors are practising Complementary Health Practitioners who use dowsing to speed up and enhance assessment of client needs.

You will be amazed at how enhancing your dowsing skills will heighten your awareness and broaden your understanding of the subtle energies which are present in and around the human body.

**Course 1** is a general introduction to the subject. You will learn about the subtle energy systems which are considered to influence health. You will learn how to apply dowsing to help you decide the best way of treating your client, friend or family member. This is always a popular course for anyone interested in maintaining good health.

**Course 2** takes exploring this knowledge further with more opportunities to practise what you have learnt in a safe and responsible environment. More techniques for choice of remedy are covered.
